
Status Of Debris Clean-Up




Mobile, Alabama: City/County

The US Army Corps of Engineers, under the direction of FEMA, is overseeing the work of Phillips & Jordon in the removal of **Hurricane Ivan** debris from around the city and county of Mobile. The map at left shows the zones into which the county has been divided. The grey zone downtown in the city of Mobile is being addressed by the City of Mobile. The graph below indicates the actual volume of debris that has been collected and the estimated completion level based on estimated total debris in each zone.

Progress of the First Pass of Debris Collection by Zone:

Estimated percent complete and the number of cubic yards of debris that have been collected in each zone as of **Wednesday, October 13th.**
